School Service refers to work done to better the Mirman School environment. All Upper School students are expected to perform three hours annually in service to the school. It is typically work done on campus during non-school hours. Opportunities include volunteering at the annual Spring Fair, working as an assistant in an after school class, assisting at the Friday morning recycling center, working at the Thursday morning breakfast, the collecting and storing of lunch time plastic bottles, stuffing envelopes, acting as an usher at school events or assisting the Athletic Department by staffing after-school athletic games.

By encouraging a tradition of service to their immediate community, Mirman School hopes to instill in its students the understanding that our actions impact the quality of our lives.

Completion of three hours of school service is an annual requirement. Completion of the school service requirement is noted on the students' transcripts when applying out and reviewed by other schools.
